- Be at least 18 years old and at most 32 years old on 01 January 2023.
- b. For workers: State employees, private, lay private and private denominational workers
 - Be of Cameroonian or foreign nationality of both sexes;
 - Be at least 21 years old and at most 45 years old on 01 January 2023.

2. SPECIFIC CONDITIONS

To apply, you should have one of the following qualifications:

- a. For the following fields of study Nursing Assistants, Community Health Assistants and Assistant Health Technicians:
 - BEPC;
 - CAP in Home Economics;
 - CAP in Medical Secretariat;
 - GCE O/L General Education in 4 papers, excluding religion

IV. COMPOSITION OF THE APPLICATION FILE

Complete files should include the following documents:

- 1. A form to be filled in and printed by the candidate on the websites www.concoursminsante.cm or http://concours.minsante.cm;
- 2. An application form stamped at 1500 CFA francs dated and signed by the candidate, including:
 - the full name and address of the candidate;
 - the field of study;
 - the examination centre

- Choice of training schools: Candidates should choose three (03) training schools that is one (01) public school and at least two (02) private schools, according to the list of training schools in the appendix;
- 3. A certified true copy of birth certificate of less than three (03) months;
- 4. A certified true copy of the required certificate of less than three (03) months;
- 5. An attestation of presentation of the original of the certificate of less than three (03) months;
- 6. A certificate of non-conviction of less than three (03) months;
- 7. A medical certificate issued by a medical officer of a public health facility, attesting that the candidate is fit to carry out the intended training;
- 8. A certified true copy of the National Identity Card or any other valid identification document (passport or residence permit) of less than three (03) months;
- 9. A photocopy of a recruitment instrument or a contract for workers candidates;
- 10. An attestation of effective presence of less than three (03) months for **workers** candidates;
- 11. An autorisation from the hierarchy for worker candidates;
- 12. Two (02) colour passport-size photographs on a white background;
- 13. A large envelope stamped at 400 CFA francs (post stamp) bearing the candidate's full name, town of residence, telephone number, chosen field of study, postal address if applicable;
- 14. A bank payment receipt of twenty thousand (20,000) CFA francs representing the registration fee for the competitive entrance examination, to be deposited at a CAMPOST branch to the account entitled "CONCOURS MINSANTE", number 12003-1100015854207013-52.

Photocopies of the receipt for payment of the competition fees must be attached to the application file. These non-refundable fees are intended to cover the costs of organising the competitive entrance examination.

CANDIDATES TAKING THE 2023 SESSION NATIONAL EXAMINATIONS ARE AUTHORIZED TO APPLY SUBJECT TO OBTAINING THE REQUIRED DIPLOMA.

The latter must provide the registration receipt for the current year's examinations as proof, and must complete the application file as soon as the results are published.

Their final admission will depend on the obtention and presentation of the required diploma.

COMPLETE FILES SHALL BE RECEIVED NO LATER THAN 25 AUGUST 2023 AT THE TERRITORIALLY COMPETENT REGIONAL DELEGATIONS OF PUBLIC HEALTH.

INCOMPLETE FILES OR THOSE WITH A DIPLOMA THAT DOES NOT COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS WILL BE SYSTEMATICALLY REJECTED.
