PRESS RELEASE

The Minister of Public Health, Dr. **MANAOUDA Malachie**, hereby informs the general public that the **competitive entrance examination** into public and private training schools for health personnel under the supervision of the Ministry of Public Health, **for the training of health professionals**, has been launched for **the 2025-2026 academic year**, in accordance with the following terms and conditions:

I. ORGANIZATION

1. For the **Nursing Assistant, Assistant Health Technician, State-Registered Nurse, Midwifery and Health Technician** training cycles:

The written part of the 2025 session of the above-mentioned competitive entrance examination will take place on **Saturday, 2 August 2025**, in the following ten (10) examination centres: **Bafoussam, Bamenda, Bertoua, Buea, Douala, Ebolowa, Garoua, Maroua, Ngaoundere and Yaounde**.

2. For the **Specialized Nurses** training cycle:

The selection of candidates for the 2025 session of the Specialized Nurses training cycle will be done exclusively on the **study of files**.

III. ELIGIBILITY

1. GENERAL CONDITIONS

Candidates must fulfil the following eligibility criteria to apply:

a. For regular candidates

- Be of **Cameroonian or foreign nationality** of both sexes;
- Be at least **18 years old** and at most **35 years old** on **1st January 2025**.

b. For working candidates: State employees, workers in the lay and religious private sector

- Be of **Cameroonian or foreign nationality** of both sexes;
- Be at least **21 years old** and at most **45 years old** on **1st January 2025**.

2. SPECIFIC CONDITIONS

To be eligible, you must be a holder of one of the following required certificates:

a. Training cycle : General Nursing Assistants and Assistant Health Technicians

- BEPC;
- CAP in **Home Economics**;
- CAP in **Medical Secretarial Studies**;
- GCE O/L General Education in 04 subjects, excluding religion.

b. Training cycle: State Registered Nurses, Midwives and Health Technicians

c. Training cycle: Specialized Nurses

Be holder of a **State Nursing Diploma** or a **Senior Nursing Diploma**.

IV. COMPOSITION OF THE APPLICATION FILE

Complete files should include the following documents:

1. A form to be downloaded, printed and completed by the candidate from the www.concoursminsante.cm or <http://concours.minsante.cm> website;
2. A stamped application at FCFA 1,500, dated and signed by the candidate, containing the following information:
 - the candidate's first and last names and full address;
 - the selected training cycles;
 - the examination centre;
 - the selected training schools: **candidates must choose three (03) training schools, including one (01) public school and two (02) private schools**, depending on the available training cycles and in accordance with the list of training schools approved by MOH in the appendix;
3. A certified true photocopy of the birth certificate not more than three (03) months old;
4. A certified true photocopy of the required diploma not more than three (03) months old;



5. An attestation of the presentation of the original of the required diploma not more than three (03) months old;
6. A non-conviction (bulletin no. 3) not more than three (03) months old;
7. A medical certificate signed by a medical doctor working in a public health facility, certifying that the candidate is fit for the requested training;
8. A certified true photocopy of the national identity card or any other valid identification document not more than three (03) months old;
9. A certified true photocopy of a recruitment document or employment contract signed by the employer for working candidates/holders of the State Diploma in Midwifery;
10. A certificate of effective presence at the duty post not more than three (03) months old signed by the employer or the competent authority for working candidate /holders of the State Diploma in Midwifery;
11. An authorization to sit for the competitive entrance examination signed by the competent authority for working candidates/ holders of the State Diploma in Midwifery;
12. Two (02) 4x4 colour photographs on a white background;
13. A large envelope bearing a FCFA 1,000 postal stamp with the candidate's first and last names, city of residence, telephone contact, selected training courses, postal address if applicable;
14. A receipt attesting to the payment of FCFA 20,000 representing registration fees for the competitive entrance examination issued by the head of the application centre.

CANDIDATES REGISTERED FOR THE NATIONAL EXAMS FOR THE 2025 SESSION ARE AUTHORIZED TO APPLY PENDING THE PRESENTATION OF THE REQUIRED DIPLOMA.

The latter must provide as supporting documents the registration receipt of the said exams for the current year and must complete the application file as soon as the results of the competitive entrance examination are published.

Their final admission will depend on obtaining and presenting the required certificate.

COMPLETE APPLICATION FILES SHOULD BE RECEIVED NO LATER THAN 21 JULY 2025 AT THE REGIONAL DELEGATIONS FOR PUBLIC HEALTH TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION.

ANY INCOMPLETE APPLICATION FILE OR ANY FILE CONTAINING A NON-COMPLIANT CERTIFICATE/DIPLOMA WILL BE OUTRIGHTLY REJECTED.

V. NATURE AND PROCESS OF THE TESTS

THE WRITTEN SESSION WILL CONSIST OF A BOOKLET COMPRISING MULTIPLE CHOICE QUESTIONS (MCQs).

NO CANDIDATE SHALL BE ADMITTED TO THE EXAMINATION ROOM AFTER 7:30 A.M.

Access to the examination room shall be subject to the presentation of the following documents:

- A receipt of submission of the application file;

A National Identity Card (NIC) or any other valid identification document (passport or residence permit).

No candidate shall be admitted into the examination room after 7:30 a.m.

The list of candidates authorized to sit for the examination shall be published **72 hours** before the date of the examination in the application centres and on the www.concoursminsante.cm website.

Furthermore, candidates authorized to sit for the exam shall be informed through SMS of their examination halls **48 hours** before the date of the examinations.

The results of the competitive entrance examination, for all training cycles, into public and private schools for health personnel shall be published by Decision of the Minister of Public Health.

THE MINISTER OF PUBLIC HEALTH RESERVES THE RIGHT TO ASSIGN CANDIDATES WHO PASSED THE COMPETITIVE ENTRANCE EXAMS INTO THE DIFFERENT TRAINING SPECIALTIES AND
